Separating Indigenous communities from their traditional cultural foods has long been a powerful tool of colonization. We are delighted to see local Nations across our region reestablishing important food ways like: camas harvesting, clam gardens and reef net fishing (among others).

We also want to take this time to share a hard truth about school food programs. Residential schools ran government funded experiments, which included deliberate, sustained malnourishment of children. These experiments were so severe that they caused the death of many Indigenous children. These experiments were a key part in establishing Canada's Food Guide.
